

Tennis Report for Robin Goodman.

I have coached Robin on an individual basis with his tennis for a number of years and he has always been a pleasure to work with.

Robin is a good athlete and has a great deal of talent for the game and love of competing. He has an all court game and despite his stature has a good serve and good hands at the net.

Since he joined the AASE (Advanced Apprenticeship in Sporting Excellence) scheme at Hills Road this September this has enabled him to play more tennis and do more physical training than he did previously and at the same time also obtain an NVQ Level 3 in Achieving Excellence in Sport Performance. As he has matured, and since joining Hills Road he has started to work harder on his own game.

Robin has current rating of 3.2 and is ranked fifth in his age group in GB. He competes on a regular basis in the tournaments in this country and has recently been to South Africa to play in ITF tournaments where he reached the final of his first event. This was an excellent achievement. He competes regularly for the County of Cambridgeshire.

Robin is now beginning to take ownership of his own game and realizes the hard work that he needs to do if he is to progress into the men's game once he finishes school. He has taken this on board particularly with his fitness.

He still has a long way to go to fulfill his potential and if he can really apply himself in the coming months he will improve considerably.
